



**ANNOUNCEMENT**  
**SELECTION COMPETITION**  
**FOR ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP MOBILITIES FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE**  
**IN ENGLISH and DENTAL STUDIES IN ENGLISH**  
**ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022**

The Erasmus+ Office of the International Relations Department organizes the selection competition for student Erasmus+ traineeship mobilities (SMP), academic year 2021-2022.

These mobilities can be accessed by the following students:

- Students enrolled at the **Faculty of Medicine – Medicine in English: 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year of study**
- Students enrolled at the **Faculty of Dental Studies – Dental Studies in English: 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year of study**

#### Details

The Erasmus+ traineeship mobility can be carried out in a university, a teaching or private hospital, clinic, or private practice, laboratory, research institute, pharmacy, etc.

Selected students will only be able to obtain funding if they receive a *letter of acceptance* from the host institution, signed by the head of the department concerned.

The new 2021-2027 Erasmus+ Programme brings some changes/new features, which are still being implemented and which concern the countries and eligible institutions where the mobility will be carried out, financial support (subsistence, transport, etc.) and other administrative aspects. As soon as they are available, they will be posted on the Rel Int - Erasmus website.

The duration of the mobility is 2 months and can ONLY take place between: **27.06.2022-16.09.2022**, namely after the exam session and before the start of the academic year 2022-2023. Students who have failed exams in the current academic year can begin their mobility once the re-session (for failed exams and re-examinations) is over.

Mobility periods beyond 16.09.2022 (beginning of the new academic year) are not accepted.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- Students enrolled at G.E. Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Târgu Mureș

#### Selection criteria:

- **FULL CREDITED STUDENTS IN THE COMPLETED YEARS OF STUDY**
- **Academic performance:** arithmetic average of completed years of study (average X 10)
- **Scientific performance:** Published abstracts in: national journals as first author (n X 3), international journals as first author (n X 4) and as co-author (max. 3 abstracts 3X1).





**Please note!** You will find the formula for calculating your score on the Mobility Online platform (see below). You will only enter the average/number of abstracts for each category. All the necessary calculations for the final score will be done automatically.

Only documented performance will be considered (cover of the journal or abstract volume, page containing the name, period and location of the scientific event, page(s) of the abstract).

*Scientific events organised in other countries, including Hungary and Republic of Moldova, are considered "abroad" only if they are international scientific events.*

- **The status of tutor/demonstrator.** It should be supported by a certificate released by the Dean's Office, and also signed by the head of the department concerned.

The certificate confirms that the student has been an active tutor/demonstrator/intern for at least during the semester prior to the one in which the selection takes place. The commission will increase the total score obtained after evaluation of the file by 10%, according to the internal rules of the university).

### Selection file

The selection file must contain the following PDF documents and each document must **not exceed 5 MB**:

- Cover letter
- Europass CV (PDF format)
- Identity card
- Evidence of scientific performance: one single document for each criterion, containing all the evidence for that criterion, in PDF format.

**Mobility Online Platform.** Starting with this selection, **the management of Erasmus mobility will be exclusively online** using the **Mobility Online platform**, a platform dedicated to Erasmus+ activities. On the International Relations - Erasmus website, you will find the tutorial on how to use the platform. **Please read the instructions in the tutorial carefully and follow them exactly.**

Please, **also note** that Mobility Online platform is still being implemented and errors may occur.
