

How to use Clinical Skills referentially:

Search

Enter a search term to search for the skill. You can go directly to the skill you are looking for from the search suggestions or you can hit enter and see a full list of search results. Using the filters on the left, you can refine your results by age-specific population, specialty, and category.

Browse

There are multiple ways you can browse skills from the landing page. You can view Skills that have had recent evidence based practice changes, or browse by specialty and category. If you would like to browse all skills you can do so by clicking "All Skills" under the "Browse All" heading.
